**Third Candle** We show love - because Jesus gave everything for us and led us to know the forgiveness of God.

**Last Candle** (Christmas Eve) Now we light our last candle to remember the birth of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. As the prophets promised so long ago, you have come to us once again; and with the shepherds, we are filled with wonder and amazement.
